### Children Who Need to Stay at Home

If your child is at home due to illness, they should be resting and recuperating until they are well enough to return. If your child is at home because someone in the household is ill or the family is isolating but the child remains well, work will be sent home for that child to do. This can be emailed or collected.

Please understand that we cannot provide online or live learning for these isolated cases. Should the whole class have to isolate, however, the resumption of live learning will be set up for the children. Thank you for your concern and understanding.

### **School Uniform**

Thank you for returning the children to school looking so smart. We recognise that the children will have grown since Christmas and that it may be difficult to get uniform items. However, all the key supermarkets sell these items and usually at a more favourable price – which is always a good thing. If you are struggling, we do have some items of clothing that we may be able to assist you with until all the shops are reopened. It is really important for the children to feel that sense of belonging and being the same as the other children – so any way we can help, we will.

On a related note, if you have any uniform items that your child has outgrown, that are in good condition, please send them into school so that we can redistribute (as above).

Our summer uniform should be reintroduced after Easter – for girls this means their school dress and cardigan, white socks and black shoes; the boys should wear their grey trousers, long or short legs and the gold polo shirt with jumper – no tie required, black shoes. Thank you!
