## **PARKING**

Mr Collins, Chair of Governors, has informed me of the appalling conduct of a small, but still significant, group of parents and the way they are dropping off their children in the morning without due care for the rules of the road or for the safety of their own child, let alone those of others. As these events happen on the public highway, it is not within the remit of school staff to 'police' this. However, we remain acutely aware of the seriousness of this selfish behaviour and the impact on our neighbours in Vivian Road.

Therefore, we need to ask for the strength of 'parent power' to support our children and neighbourhood in eradicating this dangerous practice.

Mr Collins, is seeking further information from the Local Council, with a view to something more permanent being put in place to stop this. In the meantime, thank you to all those who are safe and considerate in the way you send your children into school.

#### Filming Our Christmas services...

Aperture Photography - the same company who photograph the children - are coming into school this Friday to film all children who have returned their consent forms. They have been tasked with filming the Reception nativity, as well as the Christmas story as performed by Year 1-4, and the carol concert as performed by the classes present from Years Five and Six.

Following the recording, Aperture will edit the film and provide a copy to school, which should be available by Wednesday of the following week. This film can then be seen by parents in the following ways:

- Logging into the school learning platform via the website using the child's credentials
- Using an additional password, sent to your child's account, to access the private film which is hosted by Vimeo but will be accessed via the website.

Obviously, in an ideal world we would prefer the children to perform live with an audience but, in the current Covid climate, this is the safest and most secure way that parents can be involved in and celebrate the work their children have undertaken to prepare for Christmas here in school. We must impress upon you the importance of privacy and data protection in not sharing the password with anyone outside your immediate family, as stated in last week's newsletter.
