Late collection of children after school:

We are pleased in the main with the end of day arrangements and 'pick ups' and trust that you are too. Regrettably, after only three full weeks of term, we already notice some persistent late collection of children by a minority of parents.

We must encourage all parents and carers to collect the children *punctually*, as staff have responsibilities after school and cannot sit with children. This also very much applies to the collection of children who attend *after school activities*.

<u>Please note</u>: if you are running late, you must call the school office as soon as possible to let us know this. We will also try to contact you and therefore *you must provide the office with your up to date phone contact details* so that we can do this.

As we cannot supervise your child after the collection time, we will place the child with the 'Kidz.comm' after school club— across the carpark from the main entrance of the school - and *there will be a charge*; £5 for the first fifteen minutes and £10 thereafter.

Please note that the school office (464 2141) closes at 4:15 pm (4:00 pm on Fridays) and the answer phone is then activated. Kidz.comm will be your sole point of contact after 4:15 pm: 07963 494341.

Using Kidz.comm, we believe, is a better option than our contacting Children's Services or the police should your child be uncollected. If Kidz.comm closes (around 6:00 pm) and your child is still uncollected, then contacting Children's Services or the police will be the only available option.
