#### Life to the Full – SRE Statutory Programme

Yesterday, an email was sent out to parents regarding our Life to the Full programme. Life to the Full is a programme in Relationship and Health Education for Catholic primary schools and has been adopted by St Mary's. It will be delivered across the academic year in small units. The programme we have adopted is based on the Department of Education guidance and is rooted in a Christian understanding of the human person. Parents have been provided with a login and password to explore the website and make themselves familiar with the materials and topics covered, should they wish to.

Health Education is now statutory in schools and, as such, there is no right to withdraw. However, St Mary's will tailor their delivery for Year Five and Six to handle certain topics sensitively and will communicate with parents about this where it is necessary to do so.
