WOW bags



Thank you to parents and staff who attended Mr Blaney's talk about the 'Invitation to Mission – Philippines 2019' last week.

One of the projects he encountered in Manila, **WOW bags** – is a small ecological livelihood project working with urban and rural poor families - and is one we wish to support.

Plastic drink pouches are turned into high quality bags using locally available materials that would otherwise end up in landfill or the sea. The money made supports families to improve their income and helps them realise their aspirations to educate their children in primary school (not free!) and pay for health care (not free).

A box of bags of all kinds (see picture for shopping bag, pencil case and 'purse bag' (with cotton shopping bag inside) is arriving in school this week. Watch this space.
