# Health and Safety in the School Grounds Reminder

Please remember that at all times we need to be vigilant in maintaining the welfare of all children and families on the school grounds. Please be mindful of the following:

- Dogs are not permitted on the school grounds
- Smoking/Vaping is not permitted on the school grounds or outside the church
- · Bikes/scooters must not be used in the drive area
- Young / pre-school children should refrain from climbing and be monitored
