Extending our Provision in School:

We are currently up to capacity for our Reception attendance and should more children begin to return from this year group, we will need to revise the way we have planned our schedule – with children not attending school every day.

<u>Y1:</u> From next Monday (22nd), we are extending our opening to our Y1 children and letters/texts have been sent out for their response. Those electing to send their Y1 children into school will be notified of times and 'bubbles' by Thursday of this week.

Home Learning

This will continue with the same vigour as before and we intend to remain dedicated to this important service as it impacts the majority of our children and therefore remains one of our key priorities. This will not affect the activities or the communication offered via the platform.
