Chess Success

Alex, our chess coach, reported:
'St. Mary's played in the English Primary Schools Championship Birmingham Zone at Hallfield School on Saturday.
Two teams were entered: in the Under 11 and in the Under 9 sections.
The Under 11 'A' team won four of their five matches, including a 5-0 win against West House and a 4-1 win against Blue Coat. Ralphie and Daniel won silver medals, finishing in 2nd place. The Under 11 'B' team scored 9 points to finish 8th.

The Under 9 'A' team won three of their matches, winning bronze medals for finishing in third place. Tom won all five of his games, including a win against an England junior international in Round 3. The Under 9 'B' team scored 11.5 points, narrowly failing to qualify for the national Semi Finals.

Both 'A' teams qualified for the Semi Finals. This is the first time that St. Mary's have qualified for the Semi Finals in both sections of the competition, which will be played in June.'
