Keeping Children Safe...

DOGS: There are a number of dogs being brought into school when children are being picked up. Please do not bring dogs onto the school premises when so many children are leaving site. Some children are frightened and some dogs get a little 'excited'. Let's all keep to our well-known rules and refrain from bringing dogs to school. Thank you as always for your support and care for our children.

MOBILE PHONES: A huge number of Y6 children are now bringing phones to school and giving them to Mrs Shepherd until the end of each day due to them beginning to walk home 'alone'. Some children are being met in Waitrose by their parent and others are walking at a distance either in front of or behind their parent - these children do not need to carry mobile phones with them. Arguably, carrying a phone actually makes the child more vulnerable and a target rather than being a form of 'protection'. Where a child has a distance to go, we understand that you may feel better about your child having access to a phone, but unless needed, these items should be kept out of sight.
