Advent - Year of the Word

On Sunday we begin our new liturgical year – it is the first Sunday of Advent. This year, the Pope has instituted a 'Year of the Word' (The God who speaks) to help the Church grow in love and faithful witness to God. Pope Francis has also declared that the third Sunday in Ordinary Time is to be dedicated to the **word** of God – next year (2020) this is 26th January. Our Pope has stated that salvation, faith, unity and mercy all depend on knowing Christ and sacred Scripture. Let us all be 'hearers of the word'.

Stay and Pray

Each Wednesday of Advent we shall have a whole school Mediation in the school hall at 9:00. Please come and share in this silent worship with us.

Advent Charities

This year we are intending to support one 'home' and one 'away' charity.

Home: We have received a request to support St Chad's Sanctuary which supports asylum seekers who often do not have the basic essentials. As well as the material support, the Sanctuary also needs financial support to help those in most need.

Away: Brother Benjamin's Feeding Project (Mavambo Trust) – Zimbabwe. This programme, run by the Redemptorists, supports families who have been affected by HIV/AIDS, specifically the children who are left orphaned but still have to feed themselves and their siblings in 'child headed' households. £10 provides maize for a family for one month.
